There are so many different versions of the Bible that many are wondering, "Which version is the best?" If you go to a Christian bookstore desiring to buy a Bible, are you one of those thinking, "Which Bible should I buy?" Maybe you just became a born-again Christian and decided to get a Bible for yourself but then you were surprised to see that there are so many varieties of the Bible all over the shelves of a bookstore!

There should be a true authority somewhere, not many different ones.

The King James Bible is the final authority of the word of God unlike the other so-called bibles. The problem with those modern versions is that they corrupt the words of God and bring utter confusion.

Let's examine the modern versions and see if they can be the true words of God.

1) Matthew 18:11: (Subtracted). Why take away the verse that Christ can save the lost?! If I wanted to show a person the exact verse that said, "Christ came to save the lost," how could I when this verse is subtracted?!

2) Mark 1:2-3: (Changed "prophets" to "Isaiah"). Why does your Bible lie about Isaiah prophesying verses 2-3? The Bible said Malachi and Isaiah quoted verses 2-3.

Malachi quoted verse 2 (Mal. 3:1), and Isaiah quoted verse 3 (Is. 40:3).

3) Mark 9:44: (Subtracted). Why take away the verse that Christ emphasized about hell?!

If I wanted to show a person how much Christ did not want anyone to burn in hell that He emphasized about it, how could I when this verse is subtracted?!

4) Luke 2:33: (Changed "Joseph" to "his father"). Why does your Bible make Jesus a man, rather than God? If Joseph was Jesus' father, then that means Jesus was not God but only a human like us. Acts 7:59 and Hebrews 1:8 says that Jesus is God, not human.

5) Luke 23:42-43: (Changed "Lord" to "Jesus"). Why does your Bible say the thief did not acknowledge Jesus as Lord? If the thief did not consider Jesus as Lord and got saved, then this means that anyone could get saved by not acknowledging Jesus as Lord.

Romans 10:9 says that you have to acknowledge Jesus as Lord if you want to get saved.

6) John 1:18: (Changed "Son" to "God"). Why does your Bible claim there are two Gods? I f Jesus was a begotten "God," then that means there are two Gods, not one.

1 Timothy 2:5 says that there is only one God.

7) John 6:69: (Subtracted "Christ, the Son of the living God"). Why take away the verse that shows the deity of Christ?!

If I wanted to show a person about the deity of Christ and that Peter recognized the deity of Christ, how could I when this part of the verse is subtracted?!

8) John 9:35-38: (Changed "Son of God" to "Son of man"). Why does your Bible shows to believe on Christ as an ordinary human for salvation?

If Jesus was only a man for salvation, then this means that anyone could get saved by considering Jesus as a human, rather than as deity.

9) **Acts 1:3:** (Changed "infallible" to "convincing"). Why does your Bible claim the witnessing of Christ's resurrection is just "convincing," rather than "infallible"?

This means that there is a possibility that the witnessing of Christ's resurrection could have an

error.

So, the faith of Christianity is in vain, because only the witnessing of the resurrection is what upholds Christianity (I Cor. 15:14-15).

10) Acts 8:37-38: (Subtracted verse 37). Why take away the verse that shows salvation is first necessary in order to get baptized?! This means that salvation is not necessary and anyone could get baptized without salvation.

Acts 16:30-33 shows that salvation is first necessary before baptism.
