This is the second part to the article series "So Many Different Bibles!" There are so many different versions of the Bible that many are wondering, "Which version is the best?" If you go to a Christian bookstore desiring to buy a Bible, are you one of those thinking, "Which Bible should I buy?" Maybe you just became a born-again Christian and decided to get a Bible for yourself but then you were surprised to see that there are so many varieties of the Bible all over the shelves of a bookstore! There should be a true authority somewhere, not many different ones. The King James Bible is the final authority of the word of God unlike the other so-called bibles. The problem with those modern versions is that they corrupt the words of God and bring utter confusion. Let's examine more verses in the modern versions and see if they can be the true words of God.

- 11) Philippians 2:5-6: (Changed part of verse 6 to indicate Jesus denying his own deity). Why does your Bible show that Jesus denied His own deity with God? This means that Jesus is not part of the deity of God. In John 10:30, Jesus considered Himself in deity with God.
- 12) Colossians 1:14: (Subtracted "through his blood"). Why does your Bible take away the answer to our redemption?! If I wanted to show a person the answer to our redemption, how could I when this part of the verse is subtracted?!
- 13) I Timothy 3:16: (Changed "God" to "He"). Why does your Bible change the idea that God was manifested in the flesh?! If God was never manifested in the flesh, then this means Jesus could never be the "God was manifested in the flesh." How could I show the verse that "God manifested in the flesh" is Jesus when this verse changed "God" to "He"?!
- 14) I Timothy 6:20: (Changed "science" to "knowledge"). Why does your Bible rid the word "science"?! If I wanted to show the verse that there are false sciences (like Evolution), how could I when this verse (which is the only verse in the entire Bible that mentions "science falsely so called") is gone?!
- 15) 1 Peter 2:2: (Changed "grow thereby" to "grow up in your salvation"). Why does your Bible show there are certain growth stages to reach salvation?! There is no such growth stage. The Bible plainly said to grow in the word of God. Ephesians 2:8-9 says salvation is free, not worked for by certain growth stages.
- 16) 1 John 5:7: (Subtracted the last half of the verse). Why does your Bible erase the Persons of the Trinity?! If I wanted to show the verse that Jesus, God, and the Holy Ghost are One, how could I when this part of the verse is removed?!

- 17) 2 Samuel 21:19: (Subtracted "the brother of"). Why does your Bible lie that Elhanan killed Goliath? 1 Samuel 21:9 says David killed Goliath. Also, 1 Chronicles 20:5 says Elhanan killed the brother of Goliath.
- 18) Mark 9:42: (Subtracted "in me"). Why does your Bible show that you can believe in anything? This means that there is nothing wrong with believing in anything you want to believe. Acts 16:31 and John 14:7 says that belief on Jesus is the only way to Heaven.
- 19) John 6:47: (Subtracted "on me"). Why does your Bible say that as long as you believe in anything, you have everlasting life? This means that any religious person is saved. I John 5:11-13 says that belief on Jesus is what gives you everlasting life.
- 20) John 4:24: (Changed "God is a spirit" to "God is spirit"). Why does your Bible imply God can be an antichrist? If "God is spirit," or "spirit is God," then this means "the spirit of antichrist" (1 Jn. 4:3) can be God. After all, when you say, "spirit is God," you are not making any distinction at all.
